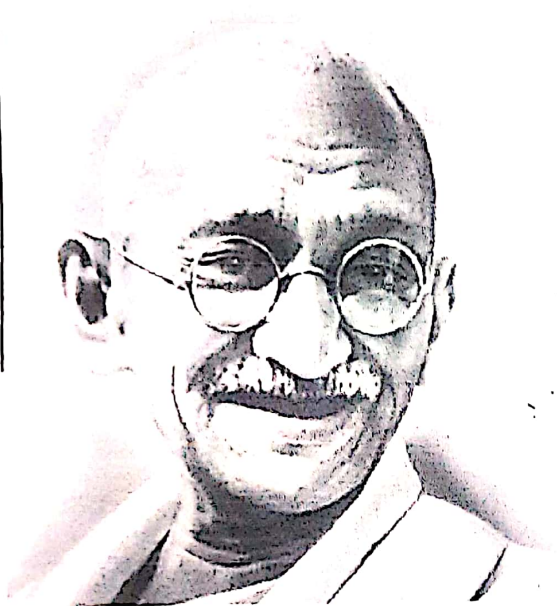



In India, the idea of involving students in the task of National Service dates to the times of Mahatma Gandhi. According to him, the first duty of the students should be not to treat their study period as one opportunity for indulgence in intellectual luxury but to prepare themselves for absolute dedication in the service of needy village people.

In India, NSS was started on 24-09-1969 during the "Gandhi Centenary year. Gandhiji inspired ten Indian youth to understand their social responsibility and to establish a


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meaningful linkage between the college students (campus) and the community for social upliftment.

It started with an enrolment of 40000 students in 37 universities in 1969. Presently coverage of NSS students has increased to 34,00,000 in 336 universities, colleges, and technical institutions.

NSS aims to give the higher education system an extensive dimension and orient the youth to community services.

Personality Development of volunteers through community services".

Secondary Objectives: -

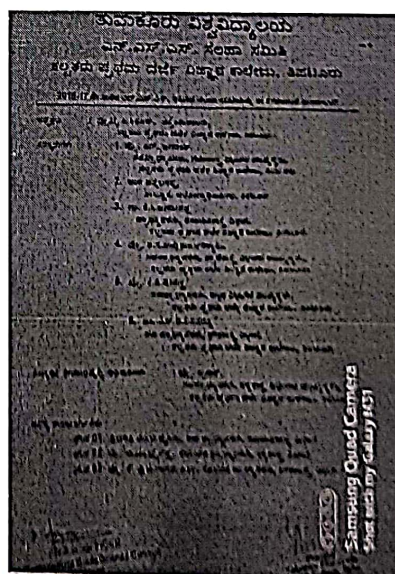
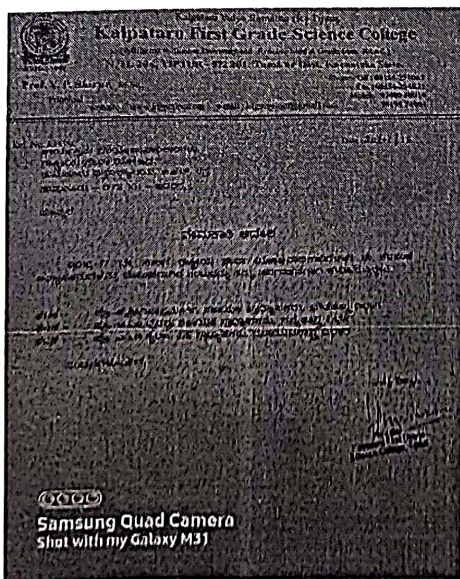
- 1) To understand the community in which they work.

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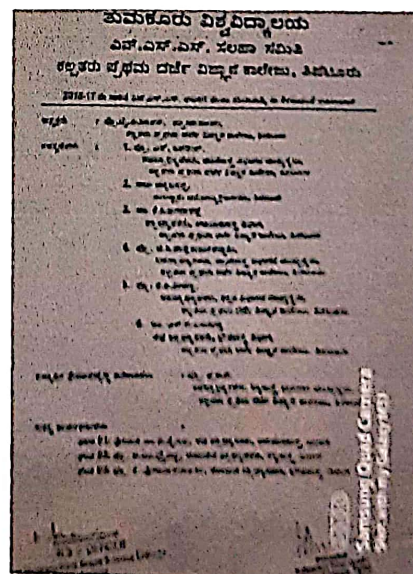
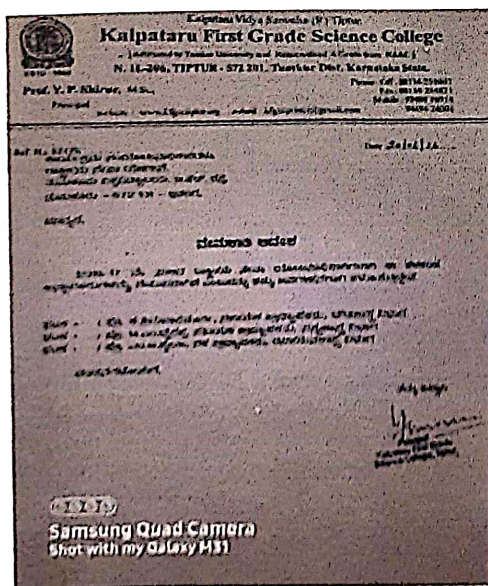
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SPECIAL CAMP REPORT

On 11.03.2018, Lt. B. Hariprasad, CEO of Gurukulanandashrama Tiptur, lectured on 'Youth In Rural Development.'


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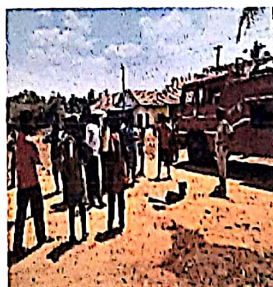
The same day, Dr Shankar M.H. Scientist KVK Konehalli, Tiptur, spoke on **"Modernisation of Agricultural Practices."**

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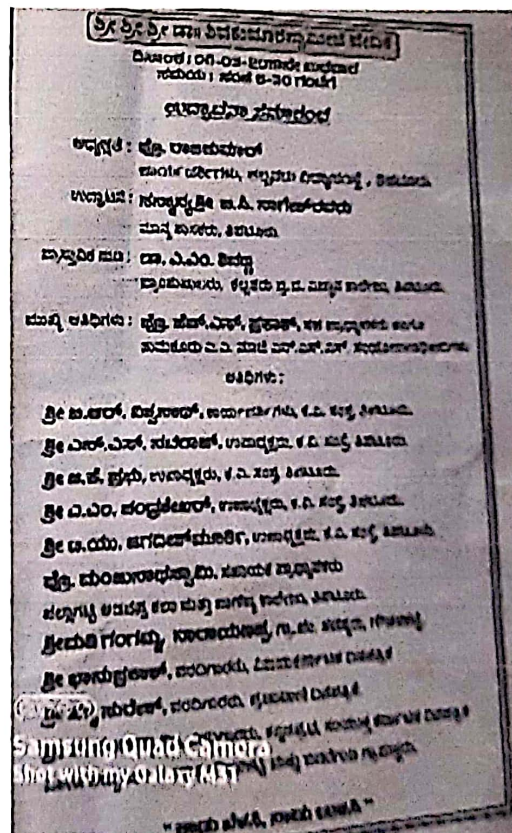
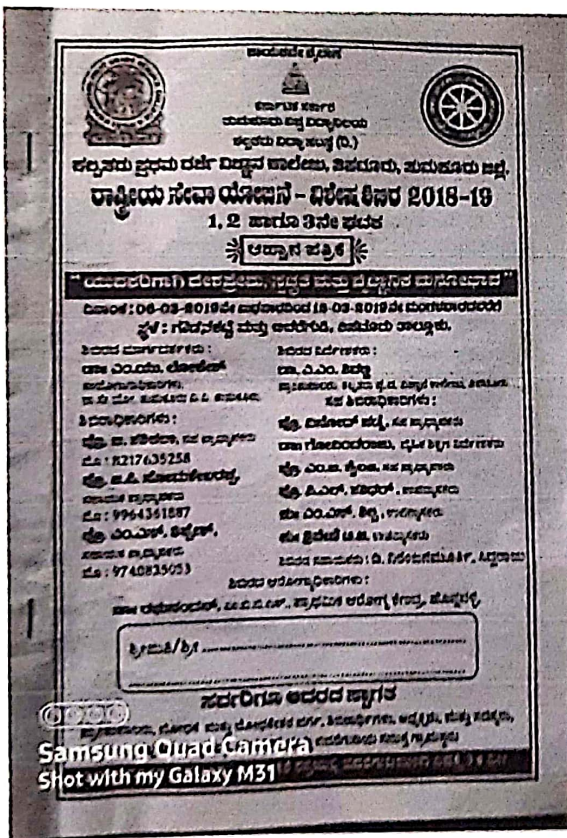


NSS REPORT: 2018 – 19

Dr Mruthyunjaya, veterinary officer, Honnavalli talked about 'Caring and Nurturing Cattle.'



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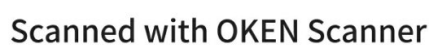

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NSS REPORT: 2019-2020

Resource Person: Omkarappa P, CDPO, Tiptur.


He highlighted the Child Marriage Act provides that the minimum age of marriage is 21 years for males and 18 years for females.

He focused his talk on the advantages of Solar Energy and how it reduces carbon emissions.



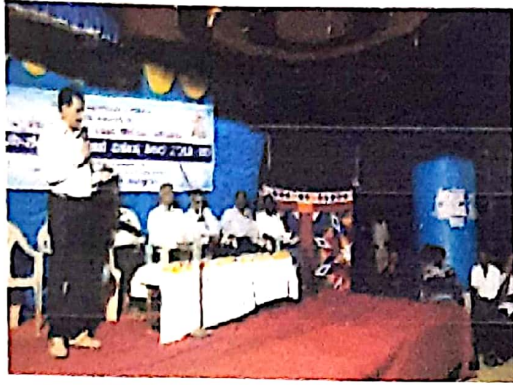
1. Topic: Symptoms and Diagnosis of Covid Virus
